FIRST ENGLISH LUTHERAN CHURCH BOARD MEETING

Council Minutes – July 8, 2024 (not yet approved)

Members present: Jon Anderson (president), Ellie Helgeson (vice president) and Lay Ministry, Becky Parker (treasurer) and Stewardship, Julie Schneider – Stewardship, Darin Ehrenberg- Stewardship, Kristi Ehrenberg – Lay Ministry, Cody Backstrand – Lay Ministry, Marla Strei - Evangelism, Josh Wollschlager, and Barbara Wegner-Secretary.

Meeting was called to order by President Jon Anderson with a prayer at 7:05 pm.

Becky recommended saying yes on the Ministry Site Profile to allowing the new pastor to have a Sabbatical Leave and Parental Leave. We used to allow Sabbatical Leave allowed for the pastor. It was removed in the past due to not foreseeing a pastor at FELC using it. But it was discussed that if this is in the Synod Guidelines and if this is what other churches are doing, we should allow it as well. The Sabbatical Leave (paid time up to 12 weeks) would not be able to be taken by the pastor until five years of service and after the Sabbatical they would be required to stay for another year. There was a Sabbatical fund in the past. After we hire a pastor, we should start to fund that again. Parental leave is 6 weeks paid time. Saying that we will do this will make our church look more attractive to prospective pastors.

Approved saying yes on the MSP to add Sabbatical Leave & Parental Leave. Ellie, Kristi MSP

Approved the Ministry Site Profile document. Julie, Darin MSP

Jon read the Endowment Fund Committee's request to give \$3,950 to Capital Improvements, \$250 to Ortonville Ambulance, \$750 to Katie's Kicks, \$350 to Abbey of the Hills, & two scholarship grants of \$400 each to Julia & Jaclyn Wiik.

Approved the Endowment Fund Report. Becky, Marla MSP

Becky mentioned that Pastor Hans Sacrison was asked to review the Ministry Site Profile document and he thought it was great. He had a couple of suggestions which were followed. Pastor Marlene had some input as well.
